



Huntsville is in the heart of Muskoka. Huntsville physicians enjoy a collegial work environment with supportive family physician colleagues, specialists and interdisciplinary health professionals. Family physicians work in a FHO model and within the Algonquin Family Health Team (AFHT). The AFHT offers palliative and geriatric care teams, smoking cessation, cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation, diabetes prevention, mental health counselling, lactation consulting and dietician services.

The AFHT is committed to supporting care for everyone in the community. As such, family physicians participate in office-based care and hospitalist care on a rotating basis. There are opportunities to work in the hospital's Emergency Department, long-term care, anesthesia and as surgical assist.

Muskoka Algonquin Healthcare's Huntsville site has 37 beds and includes a full-time Emergency Department, surgical services, ICU, chemotherapy, and dialysis, also supported by general internists, gastroenterologist, physiatrist, neurologist, sports medicine specialists, urology, GP-OB and GP-anesthesia.

- Financial incentives: under the Northern & Rural Retention and Recruitment Initiative, you may be eligible to receive \$101,040.00 over four years.

The region is one of the first approved to develop an Ontario Health Team (Muskoka and Area Ontario Health Team), which aims to improve coordination of care amongst numerous healthcare agencies.
